KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

WHAT CAN YOU DO IN CASE OF RAIDS?



1. DON'T OPEN THE DOOR

Without opening the door, ask the immigration officer if they have an arrest warrant, and ask him to slide it under the door. **Be aware:** ICE may lie yo you about whou they are.

2. REMAIN SILENT

You have the right to remain silent. Do not answer any questions about your immigrant status. If you interact with immigration agents, read the following:

"I exercise my right to remain silent under the 5th amendment"

3. DON'T SIGN ANY DOCUMENTS

Do not sign any forms or documents given to you by immigration agents without first consulting with an attorney.

4. DOCUMENT THE RAID

If possible take photos, videos and/or notes of all the details you see. Tell your friends and neighbors what happened.



5. HAVE A PLAN

If immigration detains a loved one, find a trusted attorney, have a plan for yourself and your family. Be informed of your rights and educate your community.
